



BOOKINGS + PAYMENTS

- Payment is online via card, via our booking system with payment upfront at the time of booking. We don't have alternative ways to pay or book in.
- Please ensure you correctly spell your email when booking. Our system sends all info via email and you must be able to receive it, please check your spam. You will receive a confirmation as soon as you book.
- We cannot hold dates without payment due to the administrative capacity of such a large event. There are no discounts for block bookings
- Cancelled seller pitches require 7 days notice in order to be eligible for refund, without exception. There is a £4 admin fee charged per cancelled date due to transaction charges we cannot reclaim when refunding payments
- Postponement also counts as cancellation within this policy

SELLER PITCHES

- **We cannot guarantee particular placement within the barn for pitches, under any circumstances**
- **Pitch allocation is entirely random**, you will be assigned a number on the barn map at random
- The seller pitches are chalked out on the floor of the barn. We send out a map of the barn with numbers on, the Friday before the sale via email.
- You may book an end of row pitch at extra cost, located at the end of one of the rows. You may not choose which row, it does mean your stall has more visibility and side display as well as front display.
- **If you book end of row, you will be placed either at Pitch 1, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 33, 43, 44, 54, 65. You may not choose which one.**
 - Pitch measurements are always the same across ALL pitches, even end of row pitches (2.3m wide, 2m deep)

PARKING + SET UP

- Set up is from 8.30am, **if you arrive early you must queue in the MAIN CARPARK**, please follow the cones
- Please expect to wait until 8.30am for the barn doors to open as staff are busy setting other things up.

- Sellers have two separate designated parking areas:

1. behind the main barn
2. The over flow to the side of the barn. During the event all cars are blocked in until 1pm

- You must not park in the main customer carpark under any circumstances

- We fill the barn parking first, once that is full we will allow you to quickly unload items from outside the barn and then **immediately** move your vehicle to the overflow. Vehicles must be parked by 9.15am latest.
- You **MUST** park as directed by staff. We understand people would like to get out as soon as possible after the end, regardless of this **you must park exactly where directed** and tightly so we can fit maximum cars in.
- Customers will also park in the trader overflow once the market is underway, so you must park as directed by staff within that space.
- Our biggest challenge is maximising customer parking spaces during the event, we pay 2 staff to oversee this whilst you are trading so **thank you for your full cooperation on this**

TRADING

- We mark the pitch sizes on the floor of the barn. Pitch width 2.3m, depth 1.5m. We ask you to **remain strictly within the chalk marks** for public safety in walkway areas, and for respect to your fellow traders.

Trestle tables are 183 x 76cm

-If you have booked a table, please collect it from the entrance to the barn once parked

Any type of display is allowed within the marked area of your pitch, rails, stands etc **but please ensure you stay within the marks on the floor**

-Staff will be going around checking this during set up

- No early pack ups. The event is advertised until 1PM and early pack ups will not be allowed to rebook
- No trading of meat or meat based products, taxidermy, horn, bone, fur or skins of any kinds. Leather, sheepskin and wool are permitted
- We send the layout for the event by email the Friday before each market, please check your spam
- The barn has wifi, Network Fold Market 2.4Ghz, Password Market2007
